Angle in on the long side and fit in on the short side, and you're done! The combination of a handy format of the narrow planks and Drop Connect optimizes easy installation. The length of only 1,000 mm makes handling and storage so much easier. The classic Oak Markant is also available with Comfortec. As the

adhesive is already provided here on the board backing, the floor is installed in nearly half the time of a glue-down installation. ■
