An insulating cork bottom layer provides excellent footfall and room sound reduction. Only Disano has a semi-elastic pressure distribution layer which provides high stability combined with elasticity for pleasant walking comfort. The decorative wear layer at the top makes the floor warm to the touch and gives the wood styles a matt effect, creating a very authentic appearance. And when DISANO by HARO reaches the end of its service life one day, it can be simply disposed of in domestic waste.
